Thornbridge	Derbyshire	Crackendale	IPA	5.2%	Single hopped Citra IPA. Fantastic tropical fruit aroma, giving way to guava and ripe citrus which burst through on the palate with a beautiful bitter and sweet balance.
Thornbridge	Derbyshire	Fika	Coffee Stout	7.4%	This strong stout is a bold blend of the finest Fair Trade Rwandan coffee beans, with dark chocolate and roasted malt flavours. From Keykeg.

Thornbridge	Derbyshire	Jaipur	IPA	5.9%	A citrus dominated IPA, its immediate impression is soft and smooth yet builds to a crescendo of massive hoppiness accentuated by honey. An enduring, bitter finish.
Thornbridge	Derbyshire	Lord Marples	Classic Bitter	4.0%	Surprisingly smooth with light toffee and caramel characters, a mixture of floral and spicy hop notes and a pleasing bitter finish.
Thornbridge	Derbyshire	Lukas	Helles Lager	4.2%	Light gold in colour. Crisp, Bavarian style Helles. Hellertauer Tradition hops, from Keykeg.
Thornbridge	Derbyshire	Market Porter	Porter	4.5%	Decadently smooth and creamy. Expect coffee and chocolate character, balanced with light roastiness.
Thornbridge	Derbyshire	Saint Petersburg	Imperial Stout	7.4%	Rich and dark with smoke, subtle peatiness and the power of the dark malts. Molasses and liquorice and chocolate goodness all wrapped up in a smooth, warming liquid. Finishes with a distinct humming bitterness carried well by the hop and malt combo. Current Champion Bottled Beer of Britain.
Thornbridge	Derbyshire	Sequoia	American Amber Ale	4.5%	Beautiful citrus and pine notes that come from generous additions of Amarillo, Centennial and Chinook hops. It is smooth and velvety in the mouth with the toasted malts giving it a medium body with hints of roasted hazelnut, toffee and caramel malt flavours.
Froth Blowers	West Midlands	Cloudburst Porter	Porter	4.6%	A dark red beer with a fruity nose giving way to a subtle bitter finish.
Froth Blowers	West Midlands	Jolly Brewer	Pale Ale	4.3%	Pale malt provides a little colour and malt taste, allied to the use of two complementary New Zealand hops, Waimea and Pacific Gem, gives this beer its particular attraction.
Froth Blowers	West Midlands	Old Pals Ale	Winter Warmer	5.7%	Very much a 'winter warmer', pale and dark malts, with a little addition of hops combine to produce a sweetish, full-bodied beer.
Froth Blowers	West Midlands	Piffle Snonker	Pale Ale	3.8%	Combination of 100% Maris Otter Extra-pale barley, the delicate taste of Cascade hops and a reliable wet yeast, result in a fine, balanced pale ale.
Froth Blowers	West Midlands	Shepherds Warning	Red Ale	4.9%	A full-bodied pale ale, with a deceptively light, summery taste.
Froth Blowers	West Midlands	Templer	Pale Ale	4.4%	Deliberately designed to reflect the former 'proper' qualities of Burton-style beers, meaning that pale and crystal malt are combined with British hops and necessary salts at a medium strength, to achieve a complex, balanced amber beer.
Davenport's	West Midlands	Dares Bloody IPA	IPA	4.1%	Orange and passion fruit IPA brewed with Citra and Simcoe hops. These combine to create a beer with a slight orange hue, a clean, crisp and citrusy nose leading to a lovely balance between bitter and sweet with hints of blood orange and passion fruit.

Davenports	West Midlands	Davenports IPA	IPA	4.4%	Glorious golden IPA with a hoppy and fruity aroma that combine to leave a vibrant bitter, citrusy and malty beer that will tantalise your taste buds. Mount Hood and Simcoe hops.
